## Promoting Internationalization at Home


The main objective of this event is to invite HEI teachers and international relations office (IRO) staff from different countries to work collaboratively on how to promote the approach of **Internationalization at Home (I@H).** 

I@H is an approach to enhance international experiences and intercultural skills through academic and extracurricular activities offered at the home university to all students, including those who do not have the opportunity to experience a physical mobility abroad. I@H activities include among others guest lectures from international speakers, comparative international literature or case studies and online learning collaboration.<sup>1</sup>

In **joint training sessions** (teachers and IRO staff) you will be familiarized with the concept of I@H, learn different instruments and activities to enhance international and intercultural skills at home and discuss best practices to establish I@H at your home university. Additionally, you will take part in the following activities:


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# Application for IRO staff
