Health Sciences (Nursing, Speech Therapy, Physiotherapy), Psychology, Communication (Marketing, Public Relations, Journalism, Audiovisual Communication), Education, Sport Sciences, Computer Sciences, Business Informatics, Business Administration, International Relations, Law, Philosophy, Theology, Canon Law.

Academic staff will have the opportunity to teach UPSA students and to connect with international teachers from the same research area. Administrative staff will have the opportunity to do a job shadowing and to exchange best practices in an international context.




Application

Additional information for academic staff

Academic staff should submit one or more lecture proposals as well as their research profile. Teaching units can be held either in English or Spanish.

Academic staff is expected to teach 8 hours during the week to meet the Erasmus+ funding requirements for teaching mobility.


